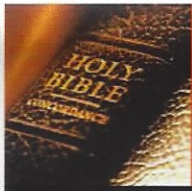

### Broadcasting to 8 Million More Souls

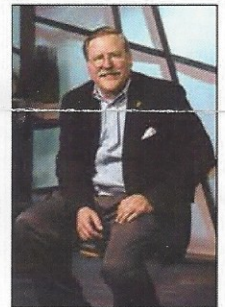

The people are indeed very religious, but sadly many have been taught the traditions of men instead of the simple teaching of the Gospel. We're delighted for the opportunity to teach thousands of these souls the truth each week.

We see numerous opportunities such as this that allow us to expand our reach into new areas. We were able to seize this opportunity because several congregations stepped up to partner with us. For these new supporters, we are very thankful.
